



Installing the ARISTOCAT Translation Software

for Windows 95/98/Me/2000/NT/XP

Important Notes:

- Before you can install the AristoCAT software, you will need to call AristoCAT to get an install code. Note that a different install code is generated each time you install the software so we are unable to give you an install code prior to installing the software.
- If you purchased a computer from AristoCAT, the AristoCAT software will already be installed on the computer. These instructions are included in the event you need to install the software on another Windows computer. You should read the section below on "Moving Your Files to a New Computer."
- This Master Load CD contains all of the most recent updates. You do not have to install any other updates you might have. You may want to check our web site (www.aristocat.com) for additional updates as they become available.

Installing AristoCAT

To installing the AristoCAT software, do the following:

1. Close out all running programs, including the AristoCAT icons (if AristoCAT is already installed.)
2. Click on the Start button, click on Shut Down, then click Restart Computer (**not** in MS-DOS mode).
3. After Windows has restarted, you are ready to install the software.
4. Insert the AristoCAT Master Load CD in your CD-ROM drive. After about 30 seconds, the AristoCAT install program should automatically start. If it does, proceed to step 5. If the install program does not automatically start then do the following:
Click on the Start button located at the bottom left corner of the screen. Now click on Run and in the Open box type:
d:ainstall press ENTER (or click OK) Note that d: is the drive letter of your CD-ROM drive.

- You will see the AristoCAT Install Program screen. Click on File, then click on Install
5. If this is the first time you have installed the AristoCAT software on this computer you will be asked for your reporter code. If you have previously installed the AristoCAT software on another computer, you must use that same reporter code.
 6. After you have entered your reporter code, you will be asked for an install code. You must call AristoCAT to get the install code.
 7. The install program will then copy all of the AristoCAT programs from the CD to your hard disk.

Moving Your Files to a New Computer

Copying Files from the Old Computer

If you are installing the software on a new computer, you will need to move your AristoCAT user files (personal dictionary, include files, et. cetera) from another computer to the new one before you can use your new computer.

The easiest way to move over your user files is to go into the File Management program on the old computer and click on the Backup menu item (if you do not have a backup menu item in the file

management program, then you probably have an older version of the file management program. It is recommended that you install this CD on the old computer and then use the Backup option). The File Management program will zip together your personal dictionary, include files, information file(s) and all of your other user files and automatically copy this zip file to a floppy diskette, writable CD, USB Flash drive or other removable media. Take the media to the new computer and using the File Management program, copy the zip file onto the hard disk and then unzip the file (the name of the zip file is abackup.zip). **Note:** If you are using a floppy diskette and have a very large personal dictionary, the abackup.zip might not fit on the a diskette. If this is the case you will get a message from the file management program and you will need to backup your personal dictionary using the Dictionary Management Program Backup option. Note that no jobs (transcripts) will be copied with this backup method. Any jobs you want to move over to the new computer will have to be copied over separately.

If you do not have the File Management program on your old computer, go to the ACAT menu, click on File Backup/Restore menu item and choose "Copy File to Floppy".

To Copy All of Your Files

1. On your old computer, When prompted for the name of the file to copy, type in: *.* (Be sure to use high density floppies). When one diskette is full, the program will prompt you to put in another diskette.
2. Follow the procedure below "Copying Files to the New Computer" to copy the files onto the new computer.

To Copy Selected Files

If you do not want to copy all of your files from the old computer, then you should at least copy over your personal dictionary and include files.

1. To copy your personal dictionary from your old computer, go into the Dictionary Management program, choose BackUp/Restore Personal Dict. and then choose Backup to Floppy. This procedure will copy your personal dictionary, information file and other relevant files to floppy diskette(s).
2. On your new computer, go into the Dictionary Management program, choose BackUp/Restore Personal Dict. and then choose Restore to Hard Disk. This procedure will copy your personal dictionary and information file from the floppy diskette(s) to the hard disk.
3. To copy your include files from your old computer, on the ACAT menu under File Backup/Restore choose Copy File to Floppy. When prompted for the name of the file to copy, type in: *.inc
4. To copy selected jobs (transcripts), enter the job name when prompted for the name of the file to copy.
5. If you have programmed your function keys and want them to work the same way on the new computer, the file you will have to copy is 'keys.dat'.
6. Other files you may want to copy are:
 - user.dct
 - *.atf
 - phonetic.dat
 - *.lst
 - *.nbr

Depending on the version of the AristoCAT software you have and other factors, you may not have all of the above files.

Copying Files to the New Computer

To copy the files onto your new computer, go into the File Management program. Make sure you have selected the appropriate Diskette drive near the bottom right of the File Management program

if you are using removable media other than a floppy diskette. If you want to copy all of the files from the removable media, click the bottom Select All button and all of the files in the bottom window will be highlighted. Now click the Copy menu item at the top of the File Management window, then click "Copy from Diskette".

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
