

May 2006 Update

This document describes the enhancements and changes to the May 2006 Master Load. Note that you must download and install the May 2006 Master Load before installing this update. You do not need an install code to install this update. We will be uploading to the web site updated versions of this May 2006 Update on a regular basis and we strongly encourage you to download each new version as they become available.

Change History

The following is a list of changes to the new May 2006 Master Load since it's initial release. The changes are listed in reverse chronological order, so that the most recent changes are listed first.

July 17, 2007

- Changes have been made to the number conversion command (Ctrl+ON or Alt+N) in the Edit program so that it works with a wider variety of the different ways numbers are written.
- You can now page number the word index in the Multipage program. This allows you to charge the page rate for the word index. Click on the Help button on the Multipag Options dialog box for information on how to page number the word index.

June 5, 2007

- In the View Notes (Steno) program you can print your notes to a PDF file. Open up a note file, click the File menu item, then click Export to PDF. You will have a file with the name of the note file with a .PDF extension.

May 30, 2007

- The April 25th change to the Print and Multipag programs resulted, in some cases, the underlining not printing and the Multipag to not print correctly. This has been fixed.
- You can now merge two edit files with time stamps and get the time stamps for the entire merged files. To merge two edit files, double-click the Edit icon. When asked for the name of the file to edit, click the Cancel button. On the Edit menu, click the File menu item, then click Merge Edit Files. Now follow the instructions on the screen. **Note:** Be sure to back up the two edit files before merging them.

April 25, 2007

Changes have been made to both the Print and Multipag programs in the way they handle bold and underline fonts.

March 01, 2007

- When in the File Management program and you append your batch file from another computer, you might get a "CT Error" message. While this message did not cause a problem, we have fixed the problem.

- When using the Alt+# (ie: 0-9) commands to insert speaker names as a By Line, the speaker names were made upper case. This has been changed so that the case of the name is not changed. The case of the name will be however you typed it in.

February 20, 2007

This update fixes a problem in the Edit program with dot command lines. The January 30th update caused this problem which is fixed in this update. If you downloaded and installed the January 30th or the February 15th update, it is recommended that you download and install this update.

February 15, 2007

- For some formats, when making a PDF file while in Edit, the page numbers would not show. This has been fixed.
- In Edit, especially when the text is double-spaced, when making a global, the cursor would end up at the bottom of the screen. This has been changed so that the cursor would remain at the current position.
- When making an RTF file, an option has been added to remove dot commands, hold spaces, etc. If you are making an RTF file to give to an attorney, you would want to remove the AristoCAT specific commands. If you are giving an RTF file to a scopist that you will get back when the scoping is done, you probably would not want to remove the AristoCAT specific commands.

January 30, 2007

A number of enhancements and minor fixes have been made to the May 2006 MLD that has been sent out on CD. If you have installed the May 2006 Master Load from the CD or downloaded the May06MLD from our web site, it is recommended that you download and install this update.

Note: The ability to change the cursor style in the Edit program has been added. You may find that your cursor in Edit changes to an underline. To change the cursor style, go into your information file, click on the Edit Options tab and choose your cursor style there. Note that the cursor will change when you go from insert to overwrite mode. Click on the desired cursor style and then press the F1 key for help.

November 2, 2006

Minor fixes to the real-time and edit programs have been made.

October 2, 2006

- The volume indicator for avsync in the real-time program now works.
- The footers in the ASCII program and the PDF file made from Edit, were not correctly centered. This has been corrected.

July 5, 2006

- A fix was made to the translation and real-time programs to correct the by line option.
- An update was made to the Edit program under Preferences. The update, Cursor after Text, changes the way the cursor positions itself after a define. Refer to the Help file.

June 29, 2006

- Sometimes when recalling steno twice in Edit, the English translation would be missing. This has been fixed.
- A strike out option has been added to the Print and Multipag programs when printing to PDF. See the May 2006 MLD PDF file for detailed information about this change.
- Changes have been made to the automatic indexing program. If you are using automatic indexing, you may need to make some changes to your index/exhibit include file. See the May 2006 MLD PDF file for detailed information about this change.

June 13, 2006

A fix was made to the translation and real-time programs regarding the beginning and ending include files.

June 7, 2006

- Several help files have been updated.
- Automatic index icon has been added.

May 27, 2006

A fix was made to the PDF creation in the Print and Multipag programs.

May 24, 2006

A fix was made to the dictionary management program.
